The chosen categories will be given out at the banquet, put on the web page and included in the summer Close Ups Newsletter.

The New Haven Camera Club will hold its Annual Awards Banquet on Monday June 9th, at App's Ristorante, 283 Captain Thomas Blvd, in West Haven. Directions are on the back page of the bulletin.

A cocktail hour will begin at 6:00 PM with light appetizers and dinner will be served at 6:45. Entree choices are listed on the reservation form on the back page. Tax, gratuity and appetizers are included in the price. Deadline for reservations is June 4. At the conclusion of the dinner, awards will be given for the 2002-03 high cumulative average in each class. Take 1-95 to Exit 44 (Downtown West Haven). Follow K-imberly Ave. toward West Haven. At the 2nd light take a left onto 1st Ave. 1st. Ave becomes Beach Street which follows the shoreline.

The road curves to the right at Stowe's Seafood. At the stop sign, turn left onto Captain Thomas Blvd. App's is about 3/10,mile on the right. There is street parking, a lot of 15 spaces behind the restaurant (looks like you're entering a driveway- it is actually a legal street) or park across the street in the shopping plaza.
